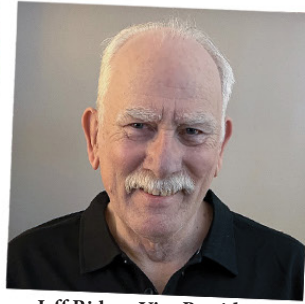
We are a club approaching 50 years old that is run for our members and by our members. Find the role that you can play to help us continue to thrive for another 50 years.

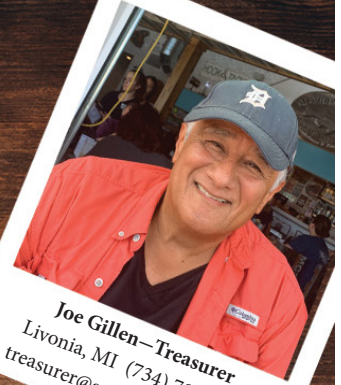

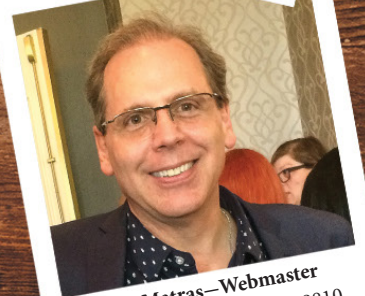

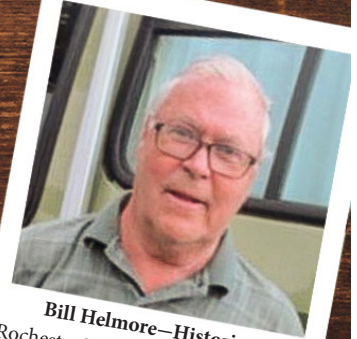

Joe's Tech Trivia

- Check your rear flex line for swollen rubber. This is the first indication the line is worn and should be replaced.
- If you have no history of when the front rubber flex lines were changed, do it now! Flexible lines can break down from within the line. The breakdown of the rubber creates a "tongue" that can drop down and keep pressure on the wheel cylinder or brake caliper causing it to overheat and eventually fail.
- Flush out your old brake fluid to rid your system of moisture build-up that causes rust. Using 100% synthetic fluid is a decent plan.
- Put a rubber cover across the master brake cylinder in the bonnet area. This serves as a shield to keep rainwater from weeping into your master cylinder.
- Check your brake line across the rear frame area. The attachment bracket is known to vibrate loose and then the galvanized line can start chaffing and wear through causing a major brake failure.
- Check out the emergency brake. Keep the cable in working condition; if rusty it could stick.



The Only Thing More Important than Going is Stopping:

Tips for Healthier Brakes

- There is a simple way to adjust your rear brakes. In a K-Mart size parking lot back the coach up and stop hard. Repeat this several times. Or you can jack up the rear of the coach, spin the tires, and use a brake spoon to get the same results.
- Rocks can wear down the brake line that leads to the multi-proportioning valve, located by the left sidewheel house. You can add a rock shield to cover and protect it. I once lost my front brakes tiptoeing through Chicago due to rocks hitting that area.
- Pull the rear brake drums and physically check your brake shoes for excessive wear.
- Check your front rotors for wear, scratches, or gouges. Change those pads to a recommended front disc pad.
- Never throw away that proportioning valve. They don't have any mechanical moving parts that wear, and the replacement parts lack quality.

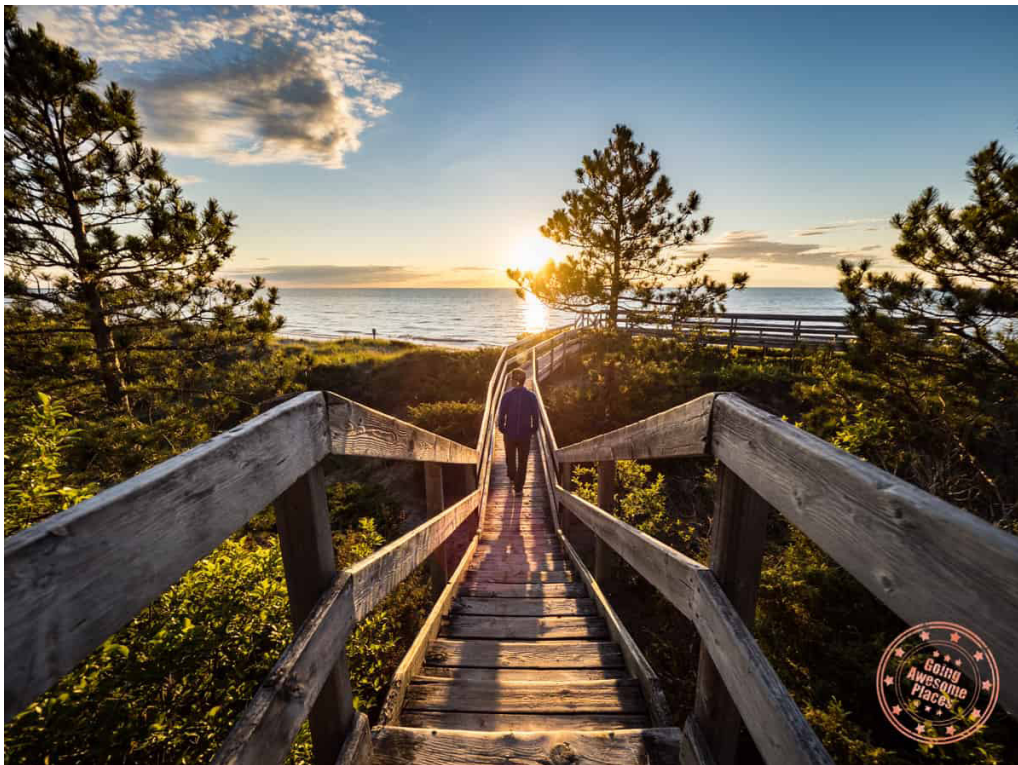

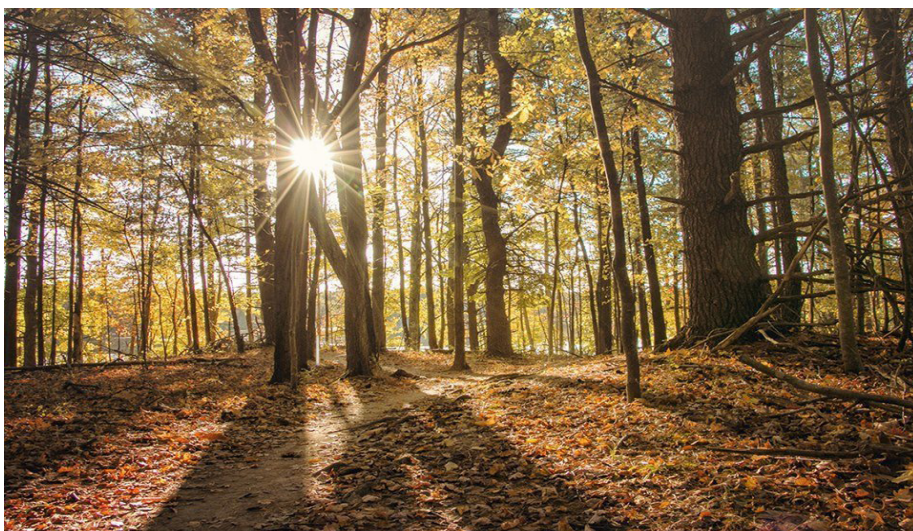

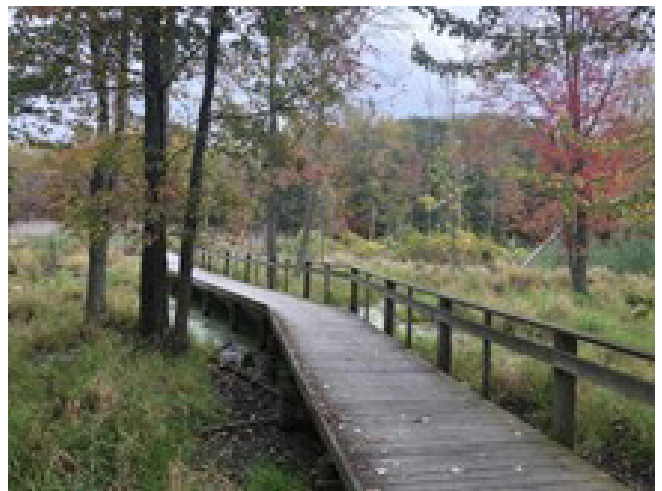
